
MYSTERY OF UNITY AND LOVE

The Trinity is one of the most intelligent definition of God we could ever imagine. And this responds very closely to the inner cravings of the human heart. Trinity and unity are two facets of the same God. No other religion could discover this mystery; only Jesus, who is one of the three persons, can tell us of this which still remains a mystery for our human mind.

But if we reflect also on our human experience, since we are made in the image of God, we realize that inside our spiritual life we are already part of this reality of being one with other people. First in line is the spousal relationship; when it reaches the perfection it is meant to reach, the two people really become one; actually, one lives constantly in the heart of the other. The same is with deep friendship which creates a unity between two people which is unbreakable and always present in the life of a person. The love of the Holy Spirit, which comes from the Father and from the Son, is in this line of realities. It creates such a unity that one loses his identity on the other. We are called to be "one with the Trinity" through the love of the Holy Spirit.

No religion could discover this reality, because it is on a level superior to our own intelligence; actually, it is called "supernatural". In fact, if God is love, He cannot be alone, because you need at least another equal partner to exchange your love. And that love is creative by nature, so it becomes the third partner.

So, we are called to build unity through love, as the highest goal of our Christian vocation. Unity inside ourselves: so many people are all broken up, all divided inside by so many forces pulling apart from the harmony and peace, which we all need in our life. Unity in our families: so much pain, wounds and individualism in our families are causing a lot of division, to a point that we have to go out of our family to find a bit of love and peace. Unity in our communities: the whole world is engaged in a deep war against each other, in the name of human rights, but forgetting that any right is based on the respect and love of the other person. Unity in our Catholic Church: between liberal and traditionalists, between the Vatican and the Cardinals, between the Bishops and Priests and between the people and their leaders. Unity is the last prayer that Jesus asked the Father for His church.
