CHRIST THE KING

But what kind of King? First of all, He is the KING OF THE UNIVERSE. Why? Because he has made it and the He has rescued us from the power of sin and death. He has bought it with the heavy price of his blood on the cross. And all the universe obeys his laws and authority.

In the reading of Daniel, we have another title: Son of Man. Yes, because even though he owns all the universe, He has chosen to become like us in all except sin; He is really a son of women, son of men in all aspects, except sin.

He is also called "Son of the Ancient of Days" that He practically is the eternal son of God, the God of the ancestors, of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

He also has a "dominion that shall not pass away and His Kingship shall never be destroyed".

His power and authority is forever and for all generations. In the second reading, we read: "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Lord God, who is and who was and who is to come"; so Lord of the past, present and future.

BUT the gospel gives us the internal definition of His Kingship: ON THE CROSS. First to Pilate He states that (1) He is King, but His Kingdom is not of this world. (2) His Kingdom is spiritual, and he could gather legions of Angels to defend Him. But most of all (3) He is the King of TRUTH. "For this I came into the world, to testify to the truth" and all "those who belong to the truth, listen to His voice". So if we want to belong to His Kingdom we must live in the truth, and the truth of the Gospel. No need of battles or conquests, just living in the truth of Jesus. The first battle camp is in our heart where all the spiritual battles are won or lost. Is Jesus really our King? Is He the truth for us? Is He the center of our Today we renew our allegiance to His lives? Kingdom of truth.

FOUNDATION OF THE SCALABRINIANS.

November 28 is a great date of remembrance for the Scalabrinians: They were founded on November 28, 1887 with the first 2 missionaries sent to the Americas.

We will dedicate the whole year 2022 to learn and love the Blessed Scalabrini, father to the migrants; and we will imitate his great heart, which reached all the ends of the world through his missionaries.

Scalabrini the Founder

In 1886, Fr. Zaboglio, a former student of Bishop Scalabrini traveled to North America and while there "he was deeply moved and saddened to see the religious abandonment in which hundreds of thousands of Italian emigrants were living.

There he found groups that could easily form parishes of several thousand people who are presently living and dying without seeing the face of a priest ... living and dying like animals."

"Your Eminence, is there no way we can help those people? People make so many great sacrifices for the conversion of unbelievers. Shall we allow our countrymen, already Catholic, to perish? Should we not be thinking of a Society of Italian priests whose task it would be to provide spiritual care to the Italian emigrants in the Americas, to watch over their departure and arrival, and to look after their Christian needs as much as possible?"
